What happens here, now or recent

- **Commuter traffic/public transport**

- No pop up stuff, rather staff up to adress the issue of infection spread
- Covid adaptation, low to medium

- **Biking**

- Healthy, bike parking promoted (bike sales gone up, bike adaptations of traffic systems slowed down)
- Summerstreet project, bikes took to the streets

- **Walking**

- Healthy, safety and prioritised
- Walk strets (permanent) and summerstreet (temporary)

- **Cars**

- Car volumes takes a toll of (street) life
- Complex, the sustainable car, infection spread...

 - No movement until sitting down
- **Care**
 - Mobility and access (via car function?), a challenge
 - Home care in pandemic times
